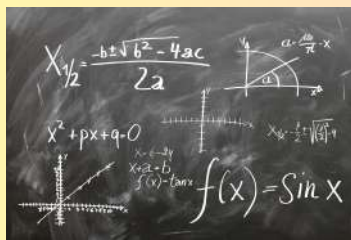
Graduation Ceremony

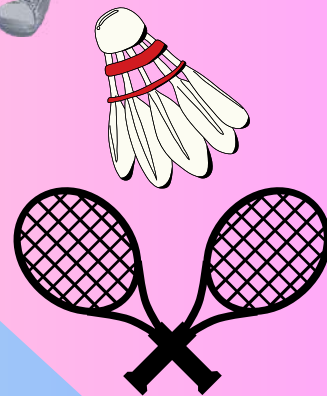
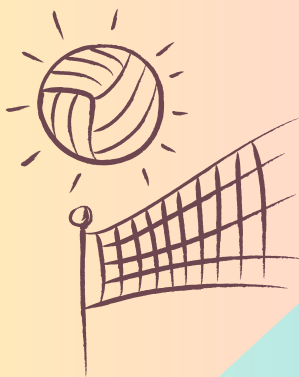
Winter Fest
