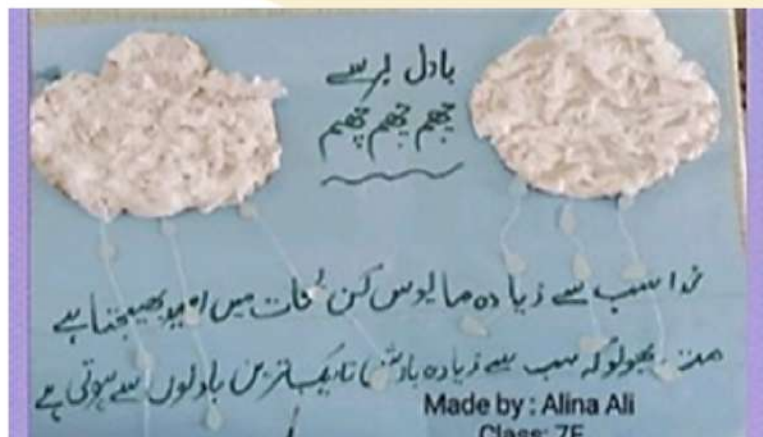

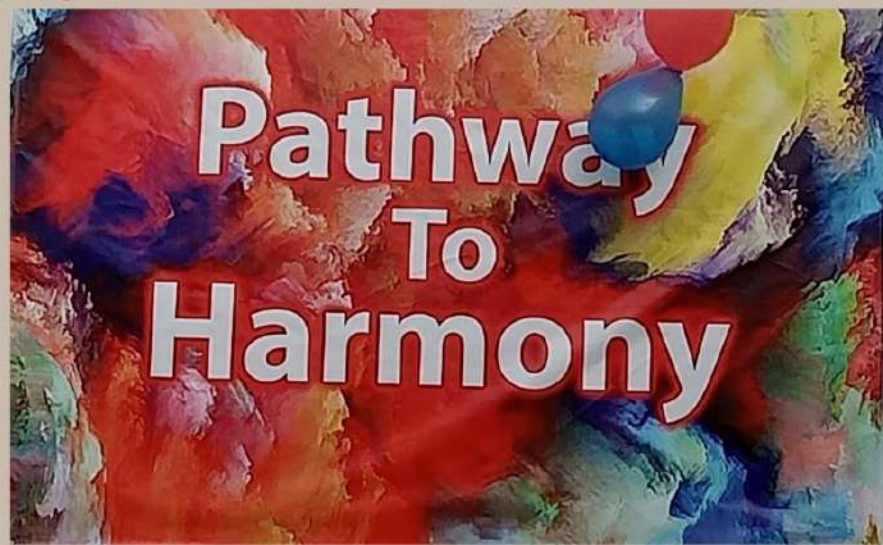
# Wood Art Therapy

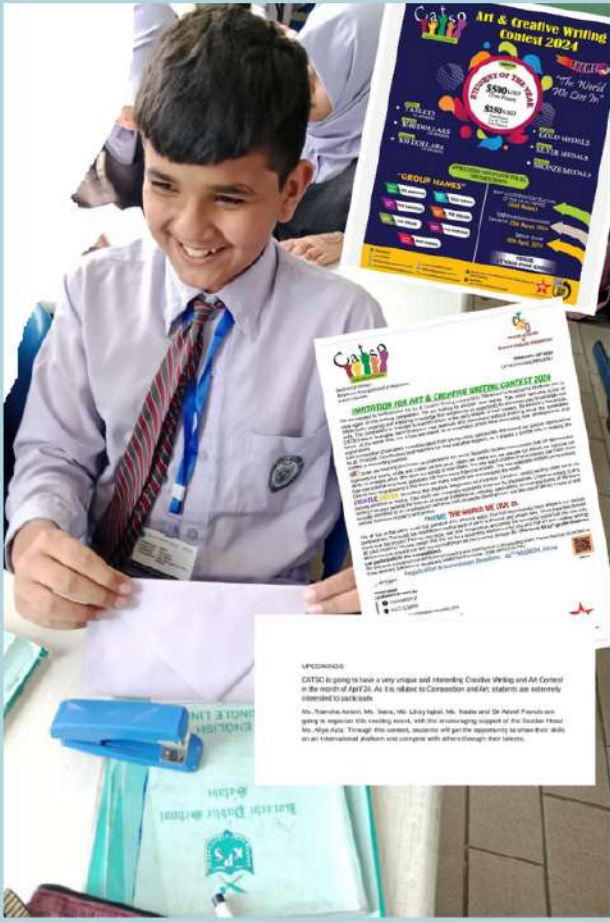
