CAPS OFF TO THE CLASS OF 2025 GRADUATION CEREMONY

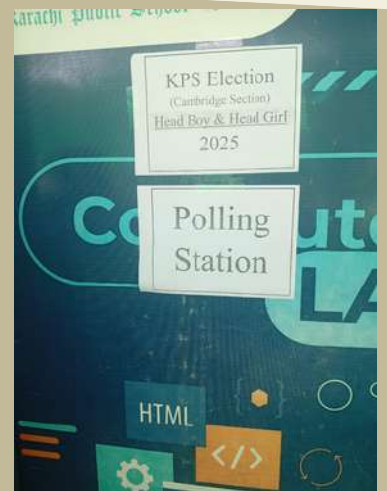

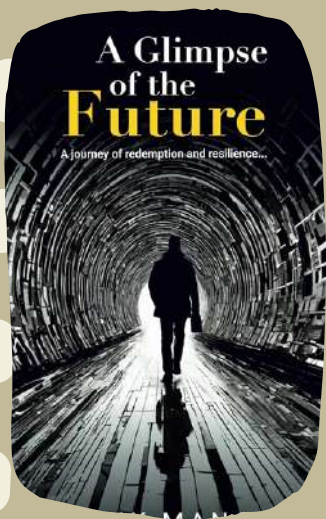

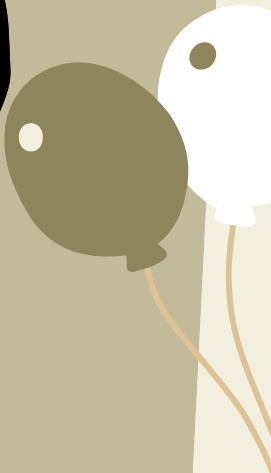

THE QUIET HIJACKING OF MINDS

It starts with a single scroll — quick, effortless, almost invisible. For students, social media is no longer just a habit; it is a constant presence, quietly shaping attention, thoughts, and time itself. What feels harmless in the moment often leaves a lasting imprint on the mind.



THE DOPAMINE TRAP

At the center of this habit lies something far more powerful than entertainment — the dopamine loop. Every like, share, or new post triggers a small reward in the brain. It is quick, effortless, and unpredictable, which makes it addictive. The brain begins to prefer these rapid rewards over slower, effort-based activities like studying. Over time, textbooks feel heavier, lectures feel longer, and concentration becomes harder to sustain.





CONSTANT DISTRACTION

This shift creates a dangerous illusion of productivity. Many students spend hours watching motivational videos, study hacks, or productivity reels, believing they are improving. In reality, they are consuming ideas rather than applying them. By the end of the day, they feel mentally tired, yet little actual work has been completed.

DISTURBANCE

What often goes unnoticed is how early this conditioning begins. Even school students are exposed to fast, bite-sized content long before they develop strong study habits. By the time they reach higher education, their brains are already trained for speed rather than depth. Long chapters feel exhausting, and detailed explanations lose their appeal. It is not a lack of ability, but a shift in mental conditioning.





FATIGUE AND THE FEED

Sleep, another essential function, is deeply affected. Late-night scrolling delays rest, often cutting into the hours the brain needs to recover. This creates a cycle: poor sleep leads to poor focus, which leads to procrastination, which then pushes students back toward their phones for escape. The pattern quietly repeats itself.



THE ANXIETY OF SILENCE

- ▶ **Low Boredom Tolerance:** Constant stimulation makes silence feel uncomfortable.
- ▶ **Weakened Emotional Control:** Lack of pause increases irritability and stress.
- ▶ **Rising Anxiety:** The mind struggles to rest without constant input.





FADING CONNECTIONS



THE ART OF NOT LISTENING.

- Shortened Interactions: Conversations become brief and surface-Level.
- Divided Attention: Focus shifts between people and screens.
- Weakened Connection: Deep Listening and meaningful bonding decline.





HEALING THE DISTRACTED MIND



The solution does not lie in rejecting social media, but in understanding it. These platforms are designed to hold attention. Students need that same attention for learning and growth. When the two compete, one inevitably suffers. Students who learn to control where their attention goes are not just improving their studies; they are protecting their ability to think, focus, and live fully.
