SUMMER TIPS: KEEPING THE SPARK ALIVE

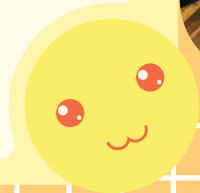
To keep your child's curious mind active through out the long break without relying on worksheets, try these simple, experiential activities:

- **Kitchen Science:** Bake together! Measuring ingredients is a brilliant, practical way to practice early math concepts like weight and volume.
- **Storytime Predictions:** When reading bedtime stories, pause before turning the page and ask, "What do you think will happen next?" to build critical thinking.
- **Nature Scavenger Hunts:** Take a walk in the evening and ask your child to find three things that feel rough, smooth, heavy, or light.



TRANSITIONING TO PRE-JUNIOR: SUMMER TIPS

Moving up to the Pre-Junior department is an exciting milestone! To help your child feel confident, emotionally secure, and academically ready for the new session, here are a few gentle ways to prepare them over the summer:



Emotional Readiness & Independence

The biggest shift in Pre-Junior is a greater focus on independence. You can nurture this at home by practicing daily routines:

The "I Can Do It" Routine: Encourage your child to practice opening and closing their own lunchbox, unzipping their backpack, and putting on their shoes independently.

Talk it Up: Keep conversations about the new classroom positive and exciting. Focus on the new friends they will make, the fun activities waiting for them, and how much they are growing.
Establish School-Year Rhythms Early: A week or two before school starts, gradually bring back early bedtime and morning routines so the first week back feels natural and stress-free.



LIGHT ACADEMIC FOUNDATIONS (THROUGH PLAY!)

There is no need for formal worksheets or heavy drilling. Instead, keep their minds active through everyday discovery:

- Interactive Reading:** Read together daily. Point to words as you read, practice blending simple sounds, and ask open-ended questions like, "Why do you think the character did that?" to build critical thinking.
- Conversational Math:** Incorporate math into real-life moments. Count steps as you walk, count out pieces of fruit during snack time, or ask them to help you sort laundry by color and size.
- Fine Motor Strength:** Pre-Junior involves more drawing and writing layout. Strengthen their finger muscles through playful activities like playing with playdough, using child-safe scissors, tearing paper for collages, or building with blocks.
